Dear Parents/Carers

We are fast approaching the Year 6 SATs (Standard Assessment Tests), which will take place the week commencing Monday 8th May 2017. These tests in English and Maths will reflect the updated national curriculum, and are intended to be more rigorous than in previous years. Children will sit tests in:

- Reading
- Maths
- Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG)

As you are aware, national curriculum levels have been removed from school assessment and instead, children are now given scaled scores. You will be given your child's raw score (the actual number of marks they get) alongside their scaled score. The scaled score ranges from 80 to 120, with the national expectation being 100.

The Year 6 team will be sharing information about the Year 6 SATs on **Wednesday 8th March at 6:00pm** in the Main School Hall. Examples of the new tests and mark schemes will be shared and discussed, as well as some ideas as to how your child can be prepared for the tests.
