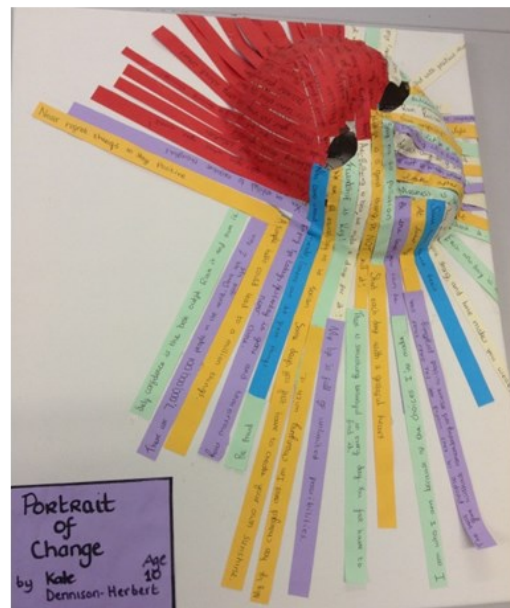
Well done to all of the children who took part this year. Each entry was totally unique and it was clear to see how much care, attention and thought was clearly put into them. We hope you will enter next year too.
