As you are aware, all of our Year 6 children will be sitting their end of KS2 statutory assessment tests (SATs) in the week beginning 8<sup>th</sup> May, the fourth week of Term 5.

As has been communicated through the reports and Parent Teacher Consultations, we are incredibly proud of all that our children have achieved so far this year, and the assessments mark the culmination of both this learning, and all that children have learnt whilst a Sandgate.

As we near the end of another busy term, it is important that our children take a well-earned rest, ready to come back refreshed and recuperated. With five weeks to go until the assessments, it is, however, important that children are continuing to practise some key areas over the course of the 17-day holiday. We will subsequently be sending children home with a small amount of Maths to complete over the holidays, and we would also ask that children maintain frequent reading.
