



'CLICKCEOP' was launched back in 2006 as an online button for young people to use whenever they are in danger online. It has already been adopted by hundreds of sites.

By clicking on the button, children can access a range of advice and guidance from organisations such as the Internet Watch Foundation (IWF), Childline, Beatbullying and GetSafeOnline, as well as CEOP's own specialist teams. Children can also use the link to make reports to CEOP's specialist police teams with over 1000 reports being received each month. 8 a day are cases where a child is in immediate possible danger. Does your child know what to do if they feel in danger?
