

### MAKE YOUR OWN FAT CONE FEEDER

Fat balls and cake are a good source of energy for birds in the winter. You can make your own pine cone fat feeder using a mixture of fat (animal or vegetable lard) and bird seed. Warm the lard, mix it all together and then push the mixture into the gaps of the pine cone. Tie a piece of string to it and hang it securely from a tree branch.
