Dear Parent/Carer,

Please find enclosed a copy of your child's Learning Profile. Within it, you will find the seventeen areas of learning and development of the Early Years Foundation Stage Profile listed. Your child is assessed against each of the 17 Early Learning Goals as either:

- Emerging - Your child is beginning to develop their knowledge and understanding in this area, yet needs to become more secure and independent when demonstrating these skills.
- Expected - Your child has secure knowledge and understanding in this area and has mastered it appropriate to their age.
- Exceeding - Your child is demonstrating knowledge and understanding that exceeds the age related expectations.

In Foundation, these skills are referred to as the 'Characteristics of Effective Learning'. These detail the way in which your child engages with other people and their environment through: playing and exploring, active learning, and creating and thinking critically. These characteristics underpin learning and development across all areas and support your child to remain an effective and motivated learner.

Finally, you will also find a personal comment from your child's teacher about their first year at Sandgate.

If you would like to discuss your child's report with their class teacher, optional parent consultations will take place after school on Tuesday 17th July. Please contact your child's teacher to make an appointment.
