Year 6 Statutory Assessment Tests (SATS)

Despite us only being in Term 2 of the academic year, it is important to share with you details and information about the Statutory Assessments that are carried out in primary schools in England, colloquially known as SATS.

These Statutory Assessments are used to assess the attainment of pupils against the programmes of study of the National Curriculum at the end of Key Stage 2 and will be used by secondary schools to predict future attainment.

During the week commencing 13th May 2019, the children undertake three National Curriculum tests; Reading, GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling) and Mathematics. Writing is assessed solely based on teacher judgement.

To receive further details about the SATS (such as dates, examples of test papers, how to support your child at home to achieve the best possible outcomes and how to interpret standardised scores) we encourage you to attend a **SATS Information Evening, taking place on Wednesday 21st November 2018 at 6.00pm in the main school hall.**
