Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Friday 10th May 2019** we will be taking the children in Year 3 to Forest School in Maidstone, as part of their curricular learning for Term 5.

Children will need to be in school at **8.45am**. We will be travelling by coach and will leave school at 9.00am so please make sure your child arrives promptly as we will not be able to wait for any latecomers. We will return to school at approximately 4.15pm. We will update you on the day via text message with an exact arrival time. The cost of the trip is £10.45. You will be sent a text and email inviting you to pay for this trip online.

In accordance with the school's charging policy, parents/carers are invited to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost of this trip. Pupils who are registered with KCC for free school meals are welcome to, but not expected to, make a contribution.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch in a rucksack and 2 bottles of water. A packed lunch can be provided from the kitchen at a cost of £2.30. Please indicate on the slip below whether you will be providing a packed lunch or require one from Pabulum. Children will not require any additional spending money.

Children should wear full length trousers to the forest, such as leggings, tracksuit bottoms or walking trousers, but not jeans or school trousers, with walking boots or trainers (which can get muddy). Children should wear their school shirt and jumper. Please do not allow children to wear favourite clothes, jeans, wellington boots or school shoes, as it will greatly impact what they are able to do during the day. Children should bring lightweight coats and sunhats, and a change of shoes.
