At the end of the first World War, every school in the area was given a memorial plaque listing the names of ex-pupils who lost their lives.

Our plaque was proudly displayed in the old school building in Castle Road, Sandgate until we moved to our new site in 1972; unfortunately it was lost during the transition.

For the last year, members of the Sandgate Society have been researching the names contained on the original board, finding materials of the correct date and consulting with a traditional sign writer in order to provide the school with a replacement.

On Wednesday we held a very special assembly when members of the Sandgate Society came in to present this to us. We are very grateful to them for this and have already installed this in the hall. The school's place in the community is very important to us and we look forward to continuing our links with the society.

School clubs have started this week and as always, the uptake has been immense. We pride ourselves on providing the children with as many opportunities as we can. Already we have 250 children involved in various sports and this number will only rise during the academic year.

It has been a delight welcoming the next generation of Sandgate pupils and their families into the school. Not only is it an exciting time for them but the existing pupils love to see the arrival of new friends and siblings. Foundation children start full time on Monday.
