Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compare numbers with the same number of decimal places up to two decimal places. • Round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number. • Recognise and write decimal equivalents to $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ • Find the effect of dividing a one or two digit number by 10 or 100, identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones, tenths and hundredths. • Estimate, compare and calculate different measures, including money in pounds and pence. • Solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.
