Bar models are a tool that are used from EYFS to Year 6 as a way to represent a mathematical problem.

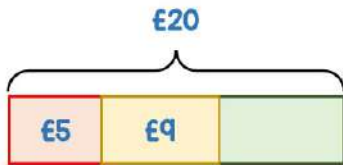
It doesn't do the maths for us but helps us to visualise the problem. It is a great way to develop number sense and proportion.

How much change does she get?

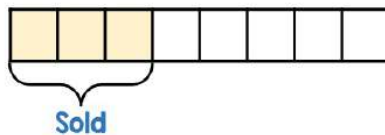


A farmer has some eggs.
