These ambassadors are perfectly suited to help plan, run and be involved in our STEM journey.

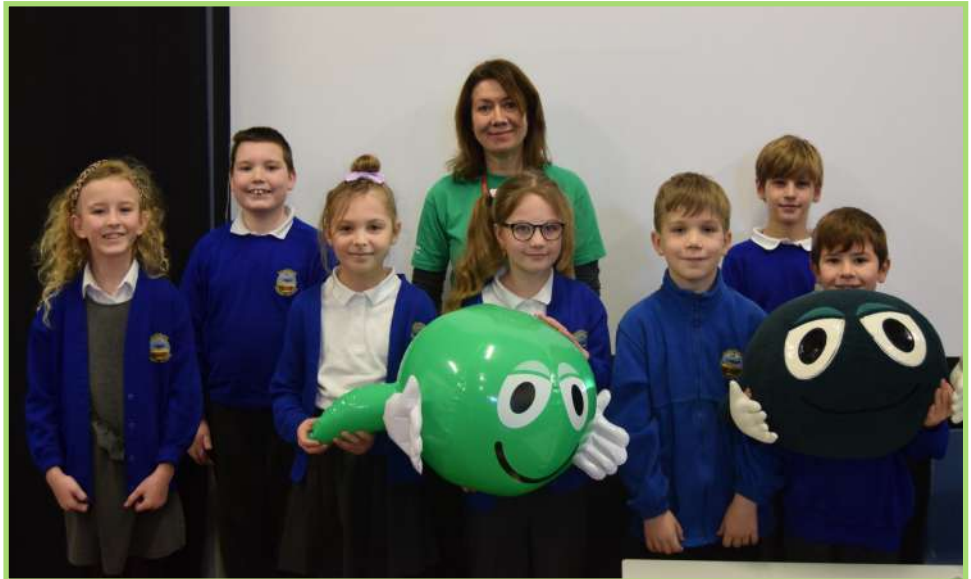

Eduspot teachers2parents app

Whilst you have the app installed on your phone, the teachers2parents system will automatically send any messages to the app instead of by SMS text message. If the system is unable to send a message to the app, it will send an SMS message instead. This will usually happen if you do not have access to either wifi or mobile data.

If you are not receiving notifications from the app, please check your phone's settings and ensure that app notifications are enabled. If notifications are not enabled, you will only be notified of new messages once you open the app.
