Applications to Secondary School for September 2021

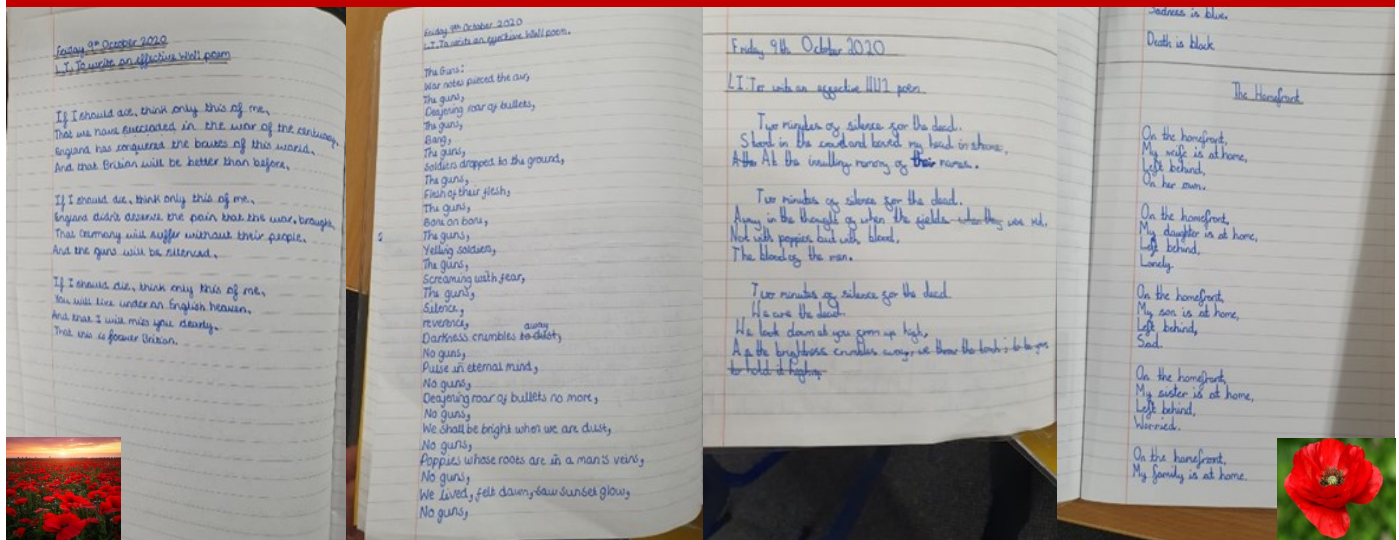
