Next week, we will be starting our Christmas Carol Countdown which will be shared via social media. I have received a couple of queries about how to access them without a Facebook account. Each morning there will be a Christmas post box at the front of the school where children can post their cards, these will then be delivered to classrooms for to be read out and displayed. Again, please can these be addressed to the whole class rather than individuals.

Lastly, I want to thank those of you that I am asking to pause at the gate during pick-up for the kind natured way you are receiving this request. I do feel a little awkward doing it, but you have all understood why there is a need to try and limit the number of people on the playground at any one time. I'll try not to do it too much in the rain!


