This week, I wrote to you all asking for your support of the distancing measures the school has put in place. Since Wednesday there has been a noticeable difference in the number of visitors we have on site at any one time. I want to thank you all for adjusting your own routines; I know that the changes we have put in place can, in turn, make your own working day more difficult but your efforts are appreciated by all.

The school is now running a full hot school dinner menu by using Bento Boxes which are delivered directly to the classrooms. Even in the first week of operation, this is proving to be a very popular option with the school kitchen delivering over 1,000 meals this week; we expect numbers to increase even further. If you wish your child to have a hot meal there is no need to pre-book, they should just let their class teacher know in the morning.

Today we have sent home initial details of this term's Parent Teacher Consultations which take place on Monday 16th and Tuesday 17th November. As we are not able to invite you all in for face-to-face meetings this year, the appointments will be held via Zoom as we feel this is the best way to ensure that these valuable interactions with your child's class teacher can still take place.

To follow the code, they must:


- find a safe place to cross
