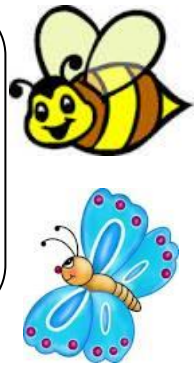


Dear Butterflies and Bumblebees,
