
Dear Butterflies and Bumblebees,

Dear Parents/Carers,

How is it the last week of June? This week the children have been busy practising races ready for sports day on Monday.

In Literacy, they have been introduced to their own individual targets and how they can think about them when they are doing our writing. The children have started 'Boxing up' their innovated versions of the story, using the actions to help them recall. They are trying really hard to remember a capital letter at the start of the sentence, finger spaces between their words and then a full stop at the end.




