

Dear Parents,

We can't believe that it is the end of Term 1 already! A big well done to all of the children for settling in so well, we are really impressed by the effort and enthusiasm they have shown and how well they have adapted to their new school routines. This week concluded our 'transport' theme, which has covered 'The Naughty Bus' and 'Space'. The children have loved learning all about the Naughty Bus! We have made bus tickets, been on imaginary bus trips and seen some fantastic transport learning. With the help of our alien visitors Zip and Zap, the Bumblebees and Butterflies have been busy finding out all about Autumn and what happens to the environment during this time.

After the half term break, our learning will be based on the theme – 'My Teddy and Me'. During this term, we will be learning about lots of different toys from different stages of childhood, linking to the 'Past and Present' in the EYFS Curriculum. For every 10 occasions that children read their school book **or** practise their sounds and CVC words at home and this is noted in the home school diary, they will receive a 'super reading' certificate!
