### Rock, Paper, Times Tables



This is a game for 2 players. Just like rock, paper, scissors players start by jumping closed fists. On the third lowering of your fist, you reveal a number with your fingers. For example, one player may hold up 7 fingers and the other may hold up 2. The calculation that needs to be solved is  $7 \times 2$ . The first player to get the correct answer remains on their chair and faces another opponent.

If your child needs to work on a specific time table (for example their 6x, 7x and 9x tables) you can restrict the game to those multiplication tables to help them secure these.

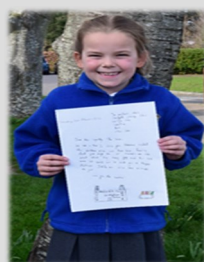
