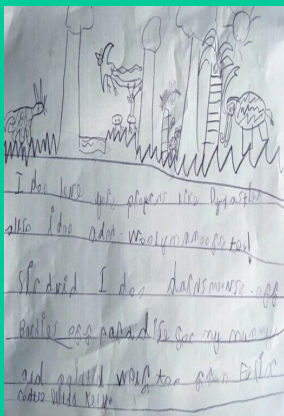

The support and donations continue and the following items are needed:

- baby formula (especially hypoallergenic one - huge shortage)
 - baby feeding bottles, sterilising equipment (nothing electric - different sockets)
 - baby food
 - nappies - any sizes
 - painkiller medication, especially children's
 - charging banks for mobile phones
 - warm socks
 - camping mats
 - sleeping bags
 - protein/energy bars
 - anti-flu medication (Lemsips etc)
 - wound dressings
 - first aid kits
 - warm blankets
 - thermal/base layers
 - hot water bottles
 - insulated flasks
 - female sanitary products
 - long life food - pasta / tins
 - summer dresses
 - bottled water
