Phonics

We use the Animaphonics programme in school. Each week one of your child's home learning tasks will be about the sound they have learnt the previous week in school.



We follow the National Curriculum descriptors for Maths in Year 1 using White Rose and the NCETM materials to support with planning. We aim to make the lessons as fun and relevant to real life as possible with plenty of opportunities for practice and problem solving.



Some of the things Year 1 children will be learning about are ...

D.T. - to look at different structures in a playground then design and make their own playground equipment; to use different mechanisms to create a moving picture.

Science – seasonal change; what different materials there are and their properties; animals and humans (their body parts; senses; animal groups and diet).

Year 1

Geography – to learn about the environment that they live in and map symbols; to know what countries make up the UK and how they are the same and different; to compare the geography of Dover and Rio de Janeiro.

Art - to explore collage through portraits; develop drawing skills through different buildings; to develop sculpture by making seasonal clay tiles; to know what primary and secondary colours are. History – to know what transport in the past was like compared to today; to look in detail about the first flight and who discovered it; to know about Dover castle- its uses and location.
