- ▶ Complete spelling-related task in home learning book

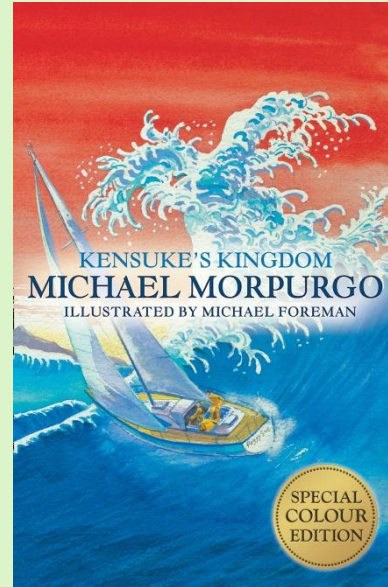
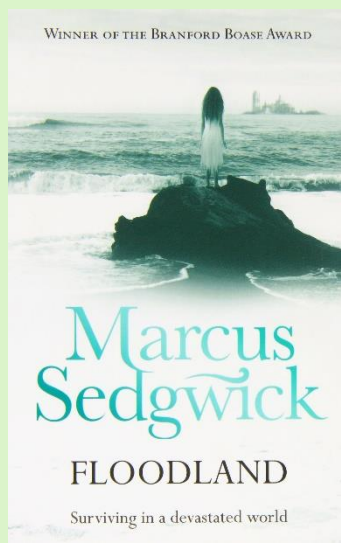
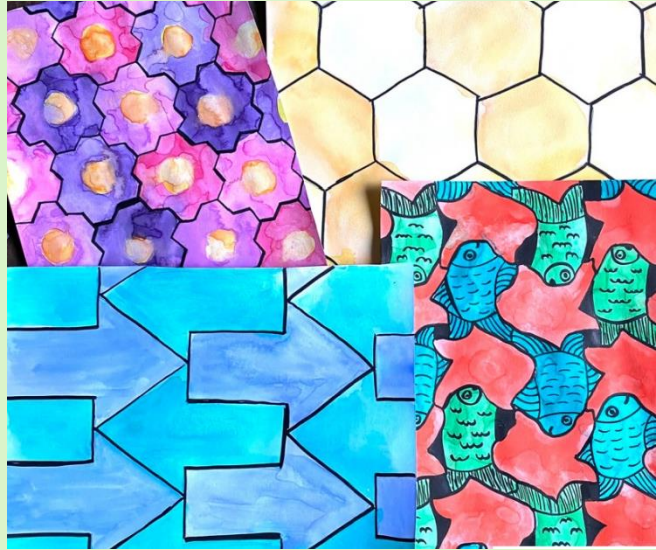
