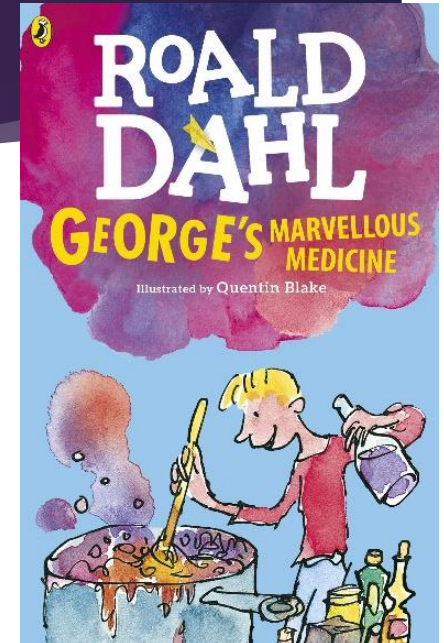
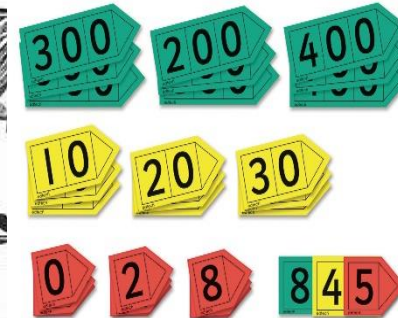

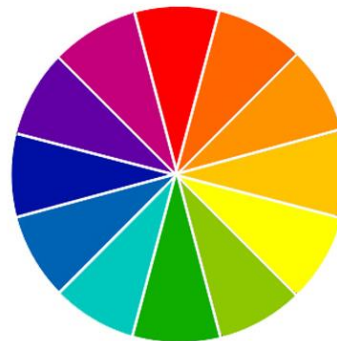

Spellings

- ▶ There will be a focus phoneme or spelling pattern to practise.
- ▶ Common exception words will also be part of the spelling home learning.



Maths

- ▶ Fluency questions will be sent out weekly as part of their home learning tasks.
- ▶ Children need to practise day to day understanding in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- ▶ It is vital that the children have a good understanding of their times tables so the more practice the better!



SATs

- ▶ DO NOT WORRY!!
- ▶ We will be completing SATS in May next year.
- ▶ Year 2 SATS runs alongside teachers assessment which means their overall end of year assessment is not based solely on the tests.
