
Dear Ladybirds and Bumblebees,

Children have been harnessing their inner superhero and have created some fantastic learning this week. They have written their innovations of the story, Superworm and have also completed their Hot Task. We were so impressed with how well they did. We look forward to you seeing their work at the Book Share. In Maths, we have thought about weight and children have been comparing the weight of different classroom objects. We even used some scales! We have also continued to work on recognising and ordering numbers up to 5, noticing that each number is one more than the previous number.

We have been talking a lot recently about who is special to us, and what we do with special people. This has linked nicely to work we have done on feelings, and how we can manage these. We have also been looking at some aerial photos to see if we can spot how areas have changed over time.

Thank you all for your support with the launch of our Marvellous Me app. We are starting to send out messages, badges and activities so please keep an eye out. The children's excitement about this has been fantastic and we have had lots of enthusiasm about badges.

In book bags on Monday you will find a letter all about sharing books for you and your child to read together at home.
