In Maths, we have been very busy this week. We have been using the song 'Five little men in a flying saucer' to help to help us think about the number bonds to five. We have also been thinking about how six is 5 and a bit, or 5 add one more. We've noticed this helps us to quickly recognise 6, especially when we are subitising!

To celebrate Safer Internet Day on Tuesday, children heard the story of Buddy the Internet Safety Dog. He helped the children learn a song which reminds them what to do if they aren't sure about something they see on the internet.

We hope you have enjoyed looking at your child's 'Sharing book' with them this week.
