- Up to a maximum 550 words for prose
- Up to a maximum 40 lines for poetry
- No pictures or drawings to be part of entry
- All entries to be legible either written or typed.

Think about your use of vocabulary and language. Have you used powerful verb and adverbs, interesting descriptive adjectives? Make sure you spell check your writing.

JUDGING CRITERIA The judges will consider the imagination relative to the subject, your writing engages the interest of the reader and is consistent in the storyline.
