Dear Parents,

This week, we have finished with our learning all about 'Land and Sea'. The children have completed their own versions of The Rainbow Fish story and have really impressed us with their sentence writing! We have also been exploring capital letters, focusing on how to form them and the name of these as well.

For our Maths learning, the children have revisited the concept of cardinality – the idea that the last number in the count tells us how many things there are altogether. We have then explored further opportunities to hear, join in with and develop knowledge of the counting sequence. We have looked at ways of making 20 by drawing the amount or by making it using cubes. Some children explained that they have made it in ones, others by using two tens or even four lots of five.

A huge thank you for attending the parent consultations this week. We really enjoy having the opportunity to discuss your child's progress with you and we hope you found the meetings useful and informative.

Over the Easter holidays, we will send a few more reading books for you and your child to practice with. As always, please ensure you are writing in the home school diary when you and your child have read a book. This helps us change them swiftly and ensures the love for reading continues.
