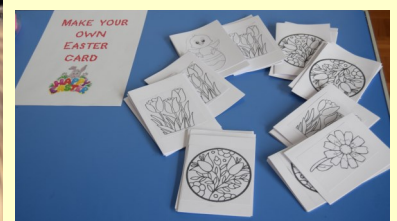
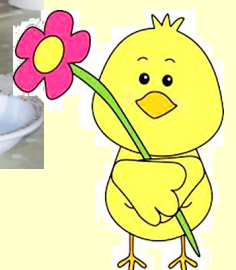




# Easter Art Attack

### **Administering Medication**

At Sandgate Primary School, we are willing to administer prescribed medication to your child as we appreciate it can be difficult for parents to come in to do this. Please see the following information in the form of FAQs regarding our policy and processes around this.

#### **My child has been prescribed medication. What should I do?**

Please take the medicine to the school office. You will fill out a permission form which will give the teaching team all of the information they need. This will then be handed to the class teacher. The class teacher and TA will decide who will administer the medication.

#### **My child's medication needs to be refrigerated. Is this possible?**

Absolutely. We have designated fridges in secure areas in both buildings.

#### **How will I know if my child has been administered their medication?**

The initial form you complete has a space for school staff to sign and date when your child has been given their medication.

#### **Should the medicine come home each day?**

Ideally, yes. This will be handed to you by the adults in the classroom at the end of the day and the form will be signed to confirm this has happened. If you give permission, it can remain in school however, it is the parent's responsibility to collect and dispose of any medication at the end of the day/course. Again, the form will be signed to confirm this.

#### **My child walks home. Can they be given their medication to bring home?**

No. Any medication must be collected by an adult.
