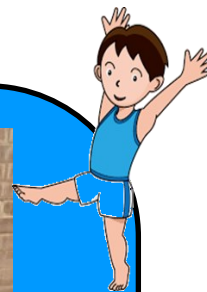


Well done to our Football team who competed in the semi final of the Herald Cup yesterday and won 3-1 against St Nicholas. They are now through to the Herald Cup final.
