In Literacy, we have come to the end of our learning about the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar. Children continued with their innovated writing, and had some really fantastic ideas; some children did different animals, while others did different foods. We were so impressed with how many of the children have grasped sentence fundamentals such as full stops and capital letters. The children have worked really hard on this story and really impressed us with their writing during their Hot Task on Thursday. This week in Maths, children have been showing off their understanding of number bonds to ten. We worked on children's fluency with counting backwards, using the staircase pattern that they've become familiar with. Children have also begun using a number line to help them order numbers.
