Dear Parents/Carers,

What a super last week of term we have had! After a very busy 6 weeks so are so impressed with the enthusiasm and focus children have shown over the last few days. We have had lots of fun continuing with our Supertato learning and have especially enjoyed making vegetable soup. The children demonstrated great control using a peeler and chopping with a knife.

In Maths this week, we have been comparing amounts and looking at whether someone has more or fewer than someone else. We have also looked at one more than and one less than a number.

On Tuesday, it was Safer Internet Day, the focus of which was around 'online scams'. We shared a story with the children about a girl called 'Samira' and how when she was using her tablet she received a message from a stranger asking her to click on a link. We then discussed how this made her feel and linked this to the different emotions that we recognise through the 'Colour Monster' story. We also focused on how important it was that Samira told a trusted adult what had happened. It was great to see the children making links and thinking about what to do if they feel confused or scared when online.

After half term, we will be starting our new topic of 'Big Blue Sea' and we are really looking forward to lots of exciting activities around the stories of – 'A new home for a pirate' and 'Rainbow Fish'.
