This week the children blew us away with their fantastic 'A New Home for a Pirate' Hot Tasks. The children retold the story so well, with their own innovations, and it was great to see so many children thinking carefully about capital letters, finger spaces and full stops, as well as using their phonics to sound out each word. It's such a lot to remember but you did so well, Ladybirds and Bumblebees!

This week in Maths, our focus has been on doubles of numbers 1-5. We have been using the stem sentence \_\_\_ is made of \_\_\_ and \_\_\_; \_\_\_ and \_\_\_ make \_\_. For example, 4 is made of 2 and 2; 2 and 2 make 4.

In the wider curriculum, we have been learning about primary colours and the secondary colours that they make when combined. We have also continued learning about churches and mosques and the special features and items they have in them.

Next week all of the children will be making a pirate ship out of junk modelling materials, so, more than ever, we would really appreciate any cardboard boxes or tubes, or clean bottles, that you may have at home.
