Dear Parents/Carers,

We can't quite believe that we are at the end of Term 4 already! This year is certainly flying by and the children have continued to impress us with the enthusiasm and determination they have shown throughout all of the learning we have covered over the last six weeks.

This last week in particular we have been very busy! We have continued looking at the story of The Rainbow Fish and we have finished off writing our instructions for how to make our own paper plate Rainbow Fish. We also enjoyed performing poetry and under the sea themed dance moves to each other.

In our Maths learning, we started the week by learning about mass and comparing whether items are heavier or lighter and using the weighing scales to help us. We then moved onto capacity and considered and compared how different containers can hold different amounts.

In the wider curriculum this week, we have recapped our learning about colour mixing and have also focused on matching items to the special place that they belong, in this case a church or a mosque.

On Friday we finished the week with lots of excitement as the children took part in 'Break the rules day', the Easter egg decorating competition and also an Easter egg hunt (kindly organised by the PTA). As you can imagine it was a fantastic way to end the term, which the children thoroughly enjoyed!

Reading Update

As we come to the end of Term 4, we are also coming to the end of Phase 4 within the Animaphonics programme. This could mean that your child has now read of all of the books within the Phase 4 set (11 books in total). Once they have, they will then be given previous books from the set, to practice and go over during the Easter holiday and until we move onto Phase 5a next term. We have also sent an additional activity pack for your child to engage with during the holiday and we would be grateful if you could work through this alongside practicing their sounds and rainbow words. It really does make a huge difference.
