Dear Parents/Carers

On **Thursday 26th June 2025** the Ladybirds and Bumblebees will be visiting Wingham Wildlife Park. The cost of the trip will be **£21.00** per child, which includes transport to and from the park, park entry and an educational talk. If your child has a Wingham Wildlife Park season ticket, the total will be reduced to £12.50 per child, providing they bring their season ticket to school on **the day before** the trip.

The coach is due to depart after registration and we should be arriving back at school in time for children to be collected at the usual time. Unfortunately, we cannot predict the weather and therefore ask that your child brings a sun hat and suncream for fine weather, as well as a raincoat! Your child will need to bring a rucksack that they are able to carry their belongings and lunch in. Please also let us know if your child suffers from travel sickness and will need to take medication with them. Children will wear school uniform but may wear trainers if they find these more comfortable.

In accordance with the school's charging policy, parents/carers are invited to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost of this trip. Pupils who are registered for free school meals are welcome to, but not expected to make a contribution.

Although your child's participation in this activity is not dependent upon making this contribution, the cost per child has been calculated on the basis of the school receiving the full contribution from every child, and as such, we may not be able to cover the cost of the trip if we do not receive enough contributions. In such an event, we might have to cancel the trip. If you have any questions or concerns at all about the contribution, please contact the school office.

As every child is entitled to a free school dinner under the Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme, we can offer you the choice of providing your own packed lunch or one provided by our kitchen. If you wish to take up this option please tick the box below, as we need to inform the kitchen of numbers in advance of the trip.
