



Dear Parents/Carers

Friday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2025

On 9<sup>th</sup> July, the Seahorses are going to be visiting F51 for their Year 4 trip. The cost of the trip will be £18.50 per child, mostly to cover the costs of the coach. You will be invited to pay for this online.

In accordance with the school's charging policy, parents/carers are invited to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost of this trip. Pupils who are registered for free school meals are welcome to, but not expected to make a contribution.

The coach is due to depart at 9.00 a.m. and we will be back at school in time to be picked up at 3.15 p.m. The morning will be spent at F51 Skate Park, where your child will take part in two activities (Bouldering AND Skate/Scoot)

If the weather is good enough, the coach will then drop us off at the Lower Leas Park, where we will have lunch, followed by time at the park, before walking back to school.

If the weather is less kind, the coach will drop us off at school, where we will have lunch and spend the afternoon back in class watching the animated version of 'Kensuke's Kingdom', which we have been reading and studying as a class and is a PG.

Children will need to wear loose fitting clothes/ jogging bottoms and tops, with trainers on the day (as they would do for PE at school) and bring a packed lunch and water bottle or two (no fizzy drinks please). If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, the school will provide a packed lunch.

We have already got a few members of staff accompanying the children on the trip, but will still require the help of a few more parents. If you are able to join us, please indicate on the slip below and we will notify you.

Although your child's participation in this activity is not dependent upon making this contribution, the cost per child has been calculated on the basis of the school receiving the full contribution from every child, and as such, we may not be able to cover the cost of the trip if we do not receive enough contributions. In such an event, we might have to cancel the trip. If you have any questions or concerns at all about the contribution, please contact the school office.
