### Screen Time during the Summer break Part 2

#### Tips for Managing Screen Time

- **Set Clear Rules:** Establish time limits and screen-free zones, such as during meals and before bedtime.
- **Choose Quality Content:** Prioritize educational and interactive programs over passive viewing. Use resources like Common Sense Media to find age-appropriate content.
- **Engage Together:** Whenever possible, watch or play together with your child to enhance understanding and learning.
- **Encourage Breaks:** Implement the 20-20-20 rule: every 20 minutes, have your child look at something 20 feet away for at least 20 seconds to reduce eye strain.

By following these guidelines, parents can help ensure that screen time is a positive and enriching experience for their children.
