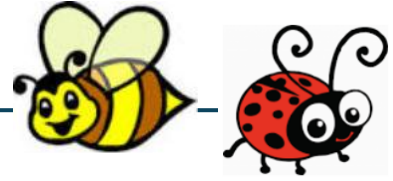


Dear Ladybirds and Bumblebees,

We have come to the end of our learning about The Three Billy Goats Gruff. On Friday, the children completed their final Hot Task of the year and we were so proud of the effort and care that they demonstrated with their writing. Looking at the progress they have made between their very first Hot Task to this one was a very proud moment for us all. Well done Ladybirds and Bumblebees!

In Maths this week, we have continued to recap number bonds to 5, as well as considering the related subtraction facts. For example, $3 + 2 = 5$ and $5 - 3 = 2$.

In the wider curriculum, we have been thinking about why the world is special to us in RE, and History that animals change as they grow from birth to adult hood making links to science lifecycles. We have also continued to enjoy our adventures in forest school investigating insects and their habitats.

All of the children also drew fantastic pictures of zoo animals on an iPad app called Doodle Buddy.

We have been enjoying spending some time in the Year 1 classrooms this term. We have spent various sessions in both classrooms, from completing our afternoon register, to having Maths lessons and story times in there, to help the children become familiar with their new environment. We have certainly seen the children's confidence develop and there is a lot of excitement now about finding out which class they will be in and who their new teacher will be! Next Thursday is moving up day, when children will find out this information.
